




Demographic Profile



- ▶ 87% are female
- 46% Hispanic, 19% Black or African American
- 14% identify as Asian, 8% identify as white
- 70% were 35 years of age or younger
- 72% earned at least a high school degree/GED
- ▶ 76% are single; 47% do not have children
- 89% report incomes of \$50,000 or less
- 41% earn less than \$25,000
- 91% reported some level of financial stress
- 64% just manage to get by on their income





193 students plan to advance to another occupation beyond a CNA/HHA.


